Residential Well Decision Framework

- ▶ Different categories - available information/concentrations
- ▶ Public Health Actions
 - ▶ Health education
 - ▶ Monitoring a sufficient period - low concentrations stable
 - ▶ Filters - if above levels of concern and/or plume conditions unknown
 - ▶ Delineation of groundwater contamination and plume conditions
- ▶ Final Solutions
 - ▶ Public Health Determination
 - ▶ Long-term alternate water
 - ▶ Water supply acceptable for use

Site Specific Public Health Action Plans for Private Drinking Water Wells

- ▶ Site Team
 - ▶ MDHHS - toxicologist, community engagement/health educator
 - ▶ EGLE - project manager / project team
 - ▶ Local Health Department
- ▶ Reason for Investigation
- ▶ Sampling Plan Rationale
 - ▶ Site Maps
- ▶ Public Health Actions Proposed (Residential Well Decision Framework)
- ▶ Public Health Action Logistics

MDHHS Funding to Support Local Health Departments PFAS Response Activities

- ▶ Funding
 - ▶ Funding moved to LHD through comprehensive agreements
 - ▶ Immediate response - approval typically happens quickly
- ▶ Budget submission through Health Educators
 - ▶ Eligible Expenses
 - ▶ Filters, cartridges, installation by plumber
 - ▶ Bottle water
 - ▶ Staff time
 - ▶ Budget templates
 - ▶ Reporting Requirements
