## **EGLE Onsite Wastewater Program Soils Training**

The Day 1 classroom portion of the training provides presentations from the EGLE Onsite Wastewater Program staff. Additionally, we have different soil samples for Environmental Health Staff to identify and practice soil texturing. The Day 2 field component will give your staff the opportunity for "real time" soil analysis with an overview of texturing native soils and verifying mottling and seasonal high-water table (SHWT), when present.
