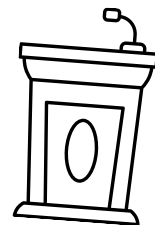
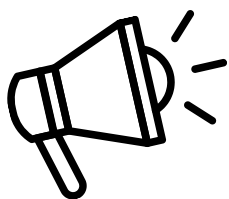

The National Association of School Nurses Framework for 21st Century School Nursing Practice provides structure and focus for the key principles and components of today's evidence-based school nursing practice. It is aligned with the Whole School, Whole Community, Whole Child Model that calls for a collaborative approach to learning and health. Central to the Framework is student-centered nursing care that occurs within the context of the student's family and school community. A circle of support is then created around the student with a chronic health condition.
