PROMOTE UNDERSTANDING OF PUBLIC HEALTH

Integrate public health education into diverse disciplines; invite local public health staff to present in these courses.

Offer public health field-based learning opportunities across multiple disciplines.

Incorporate public health messages in communications to students and their families. Highlight resources available in the community.

PARTNER WITH PUBLIC HEALTH ORGANIZATIONS

Help public health agencies **improve their ability** to collect, analyze, and interpret data to inform decision-making.

Connect applied research efforts to local and state public health needs.

Evaluate effectiveness of new public health policies and interventions.

PROMOTE PUBLIC HEALTH WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

Align continuing education and professional development offerings with core competencies related to Michigan's new public health vision.

Update curricula to address emerging public health issues and current innovative practices.

PROMOTE HEALTH FOR ALL

Sponsor public health screenings and vaccination clinics.

Integrate health considerations into planning and decision-making.

Link students to community health workers (CHWs) in campus clinics to address social determinants of health.
