What can your school do to promote Health for All?

PROMOTE UNDERSTANDING OF PUBLIC HEALTH

Invite local health department (LHD) staff to present public health concepts to students.

Distribute public health announcements to students' families.

PARTNER WITH YOUR LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT

Invite local public health leaders to meet school staff.

Join your local health department's initiatives.

Participate in your local health department's community health assessment. Share data about student / family needs and concerns.



PROMOTE HEALTH FOR ALL

Integrate health considerations into planning and decision-making.

Sponsor school-based health clinics.

Offer space for health screenings, mobile clinics, and other public health efforts.

Embed community health worker(s) into HR work systems so employees receive needed services and supports.

Adopt in-house policies and insurance plans that make it easier for employees to access health and behavioral care.
