What can a tribal organization do to promote Health for All?

PROMOTE UNDERSTANDING OF PUBLIC HEALTH

Invite nearby local public health department staff to present to your tribal community members.

Incorporate public health messages in communication and marketing efforts via social media, websites, and newsletters; follow your LHD on social media and repost messages.

PARTNER WITH PUBLIC HEALTH ORGANIZATIONS

Invite your local public health officers to meet tribal leaders.

Participate in your LHD's community health assessment.

Coordinate planning and strategic responses to shared health priorities.

Provide input around how to tailor public health efforts to meet the cultural and linguistic needs of your community.

Share data with your LHD to inform early disease detection.



PROMOTE HEALTH FOR ALL

Sponsor public health screenings and vaccination clinics.

Promote health and wellness through employment practices, healthy work culture adjustments, and healthy activities for employees. Connect to state and national healthy workplace resources.

Integrate health considerations into planning and decision-making.
