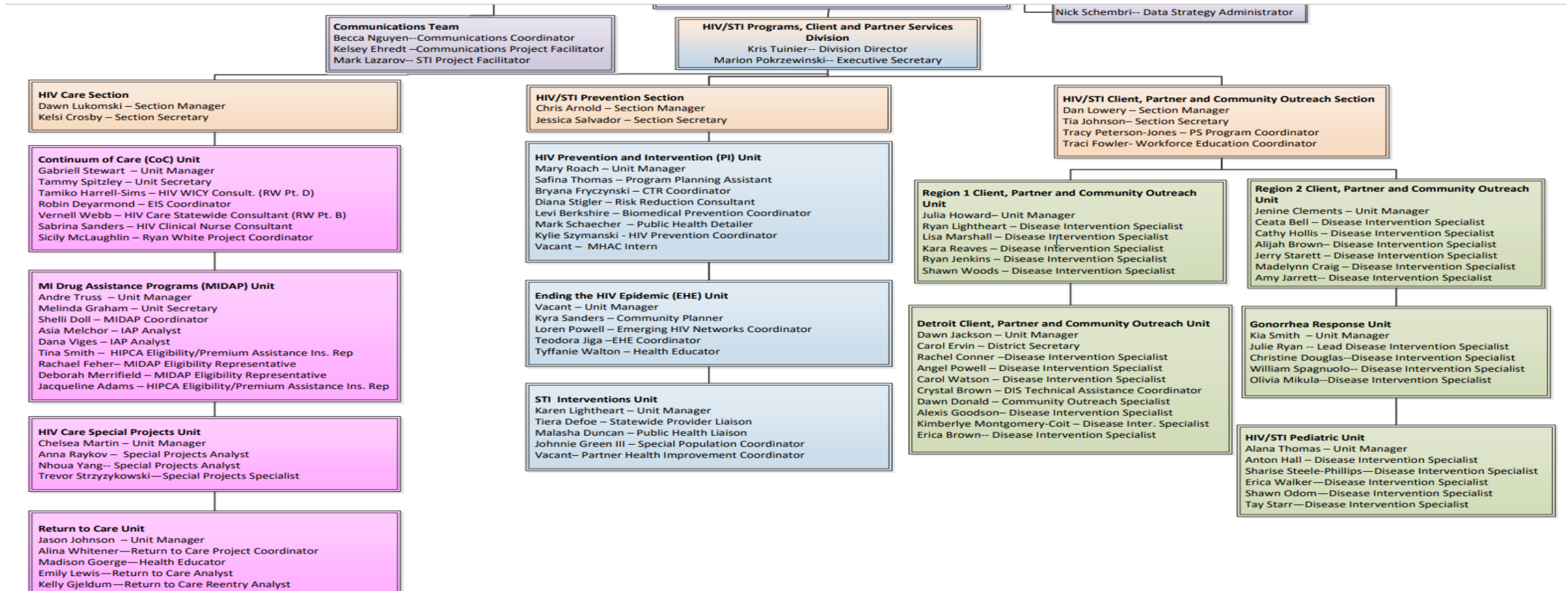

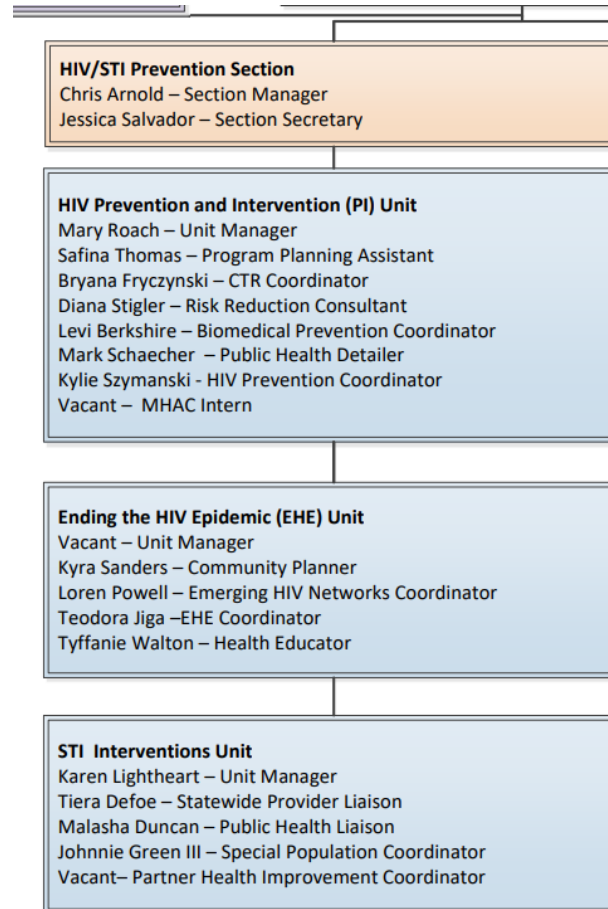

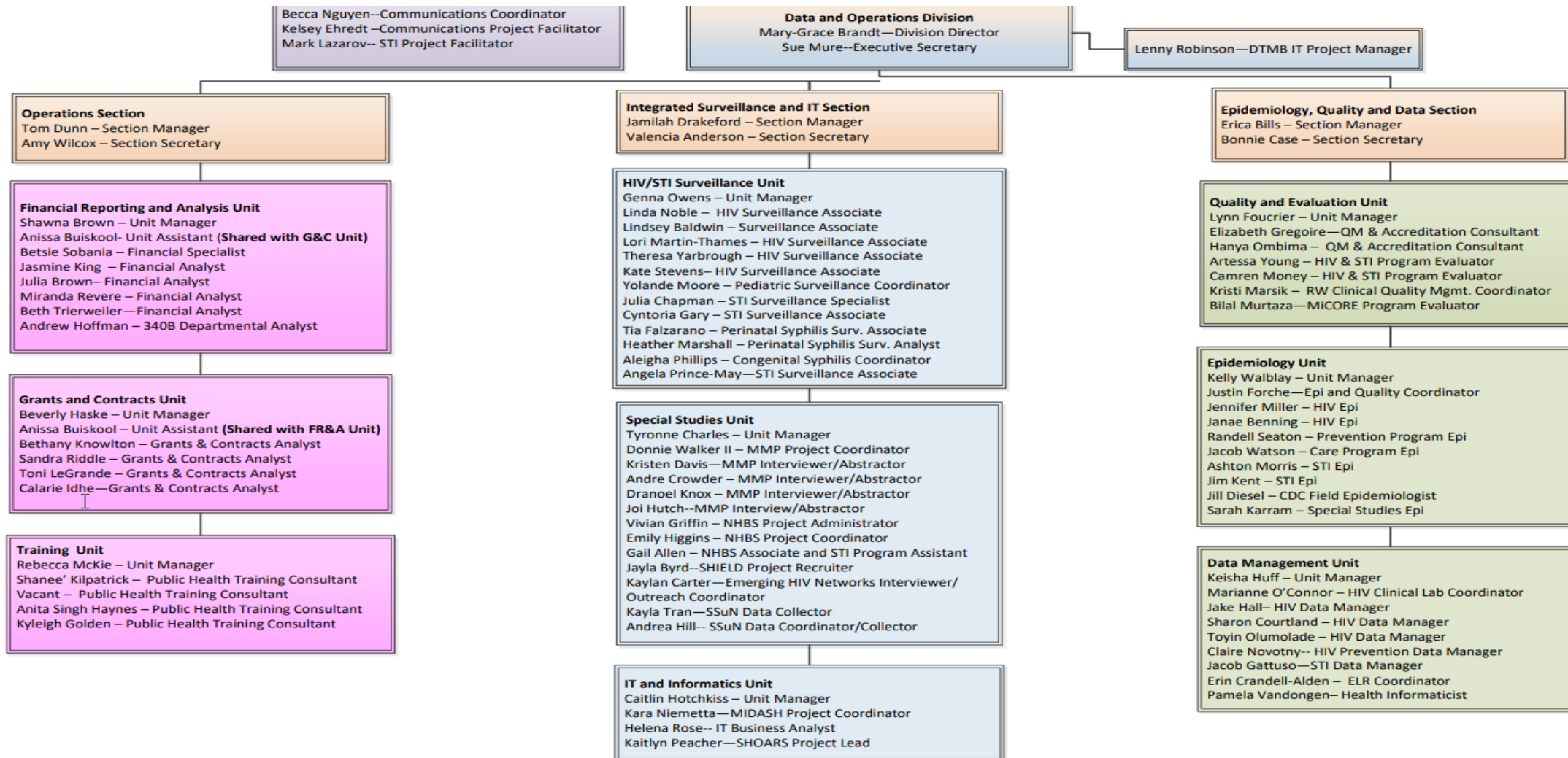
Org Chart



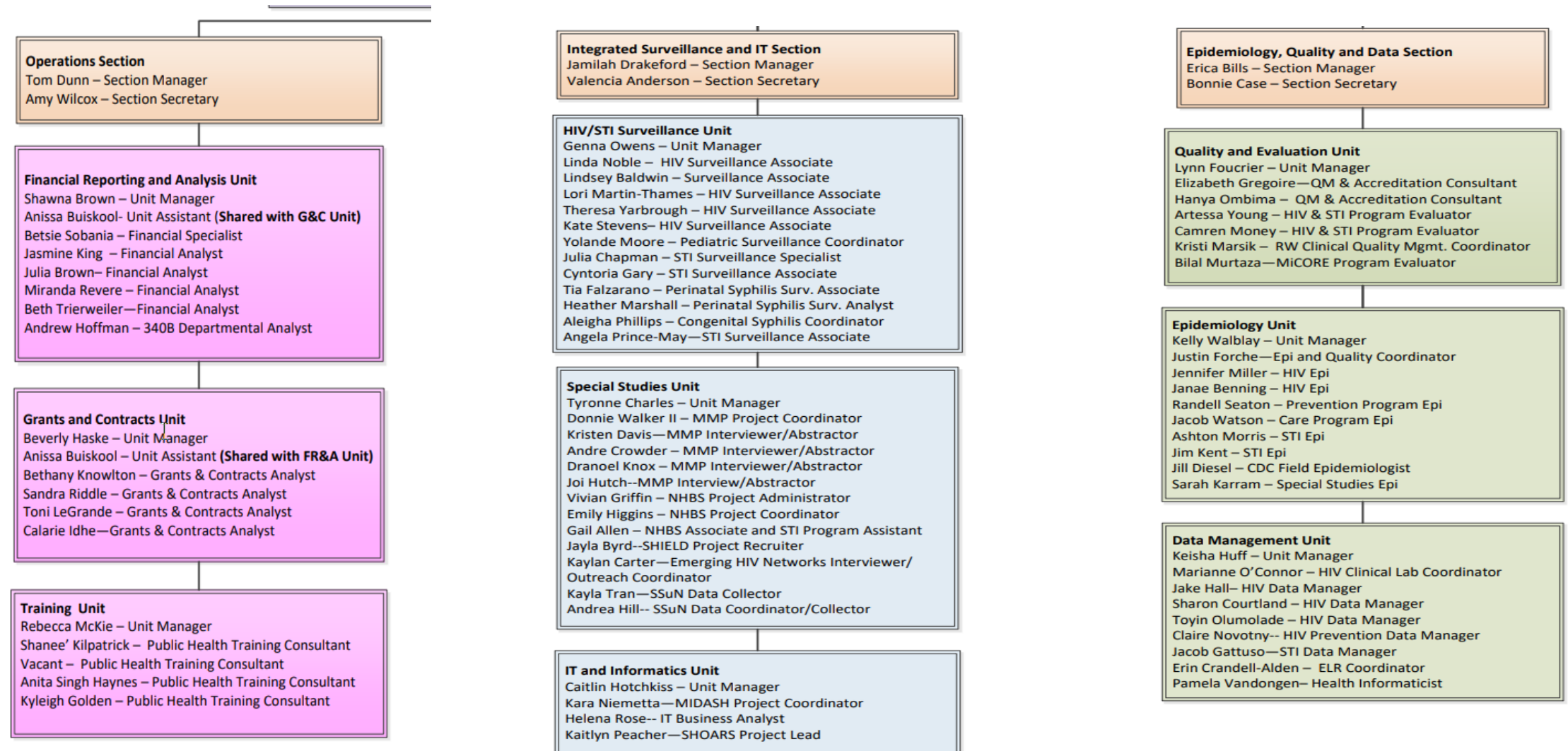

Delivering high quality care for lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, intersex, asexual and all sexual and gender minority people

Partnering with staff and leadership to increase cultural humility and ensure policies are responsive to the needs of LGBTQ+ community when seeking care and services through affirming and inclusive environments

Training



- CTR
 - Associated PD
- SOGIE
 - All existing staff funded at 25% or more associated with this contract (yearly) or cumulatively across all BHSP contracts and all new staff funded at 25% or more associated with this contract or cumulatively across all BHSP contracts are required to attend trainings to ensure culturally appropriate communication and interactions with the LGBTQ+ community.

This training can be accomplished through the Ruth Ellis Center (Ruth Ellis Center), SOGIE Trainings on MDDHS's Website (SOGIE trainings (michigan.gov)), or the National LGBTQIA+ Health Education Center (<https://www.lgbtqiahealtheducation.org/resources/type/video/>).

Please ensure all training certifications are attached for new employees in SHOARS on the agency dashboard under "Program Requirements" within 90 days of hire and all existing employees by the end of the fiscal year (September 30, 2025).

Second SOGIE Requirement

Submit a narrative or agency policy language documenting how person first language is addressed on intake forms, patient interactions and program materials. Report by September 30, 2025 via EGrAMS attachment. Monitoring will occur annually by contract managers and will be discussed during site and accreditation visits

- Grant ends 1/31/2025—so no more quarterly report after this final one
- Procuring vaccine for LHD's to order—it will be available in MCIR to order
- Please share with your Ryan White or other LGBTQ+ Health Centers

HIV Test Kits

- Instead of doing controls once a week we are moving to once a month
- Currently assessing utilization with ordering so agencies will need to submit inventory logs when ordering
- Depending on an agency stock, orders may be modified to better align with their actual testing numbers
