The Michigan Community of Practice (CoP) on Cultural and Linguistic Competence (CLC) in Developmental Disabilities (DD), was established in 2017. The purpose was to transform the state DD system with the vision to change values, policies, structures, practices and respond effectively to the multiple cultural identities within the community of people with DD and their families.
