




What is Public Health AmeriCorps?

- Often referred to as the "domestic Peace Corps"
- Federally-funded, national service program that was founded in the 1970s as a part of LBJ's War on Poverty
- Members assist in identifying capacity needed to strengthen the work of the organization (using an assessment tool)
- Members develop programming, curriculum, etc.
- Members deliver programming, curriculum, etc.



Member Benefits

- Gain valuable experience in public health, nonprofit, and/or social work sector that is not typically available in an entry-level position
- Resume builder and personal growth
- Professional development that supports self exploration as a professional and community member
- Fulfillment for members who are looking for meaningful service
- Lifelong network across host sites, Corporation for National and Community Service (CNCS) and alumni

Member Benefits

- Living Allowance (\$20,000 for full time, prorated)
- End of Service Educational Award (Past or future funds for school)
- Loan deferment / Interest Forbearance
- Healthcare + Mental Health Care
- Defined Mileage Reimbursement
- Child Care
- Monthly professional development / training
- CHW certification or similar



Host Site Benefits

- Members build capacity and deliver programming
- Build a pipeline for new hires members have been offered positions at their host sites post service
- Connected to network of other AmeriCorps host sites for collaboration
- Program support, guidance, and training from Program Coordinators
