


#### Michigan Overview

- Population of approximately 10 million
- Local Health Agencies with signed 20.88 agreements account for 47.4% of the state's population (as of 2021)
- 45 local health departments-some LHDS are more than one county
- 5 signatures
  - Academia and Government Agencies



#### Michigan Overview


- Michigan is a Rapid Response Team state
- Michigan is a decentralized state
- Local health departments in Michigan have regulatory oversight for retail food service establishments





#### Historical Success in Partnering with Local Health


- Hepatitis A in Strawberries
  - Case of Hep A in one of Michigan's Counties
  - Implicated product came in through two retail channels from a foreign source
  - Each county could look at where these products were distributed
- Histamine in Tuna
  - Counties involved in a histamine in tuna outbreak- only LHDs with signed 20.88 agreements could discuss the information with the state


## Partnering with State Health


- In 2020, MDARD's state health and human services colleagues (MDHHS) signed a 20.88
  - Information sharing has been imperative for many foodborne outbreak investigations
    - Salmonella in Onions/Peaches, STEC in Lettuce, multiple outbreaks of Listeria monocytogenes in bagged lettuce, STEC O121 in Frozen Falafel- many others
  - Epi colleagues receive information faster making response efforts more efficient
