Two Locations Available for Teen Health Services**

The St. Clair County Health Department proudly supports School Based Health Center Awareness Month. Our adolescent health clinic, Teen Health Center, now referred to as *Teen Health*, has expanded! Services are now provided at two locations, Port Huron and Algonac.

Teen Health – Algonac is located within Algonac Jr/Sr. High School. Open Mondays 10:00am – 6:30pm and Tuesday through Friday 8:00am to 4:30pm. Counseling services are available for Algonac students in grades 7-12.

Teen Health- Port Huron is located at 2215 Court St, Port Huron, MI 48060, on the campus of Port Huron High School. Open Mondays 10:00am – 6:30pm and Tuesday through Friday 8:00am to 4:30pm. The Port Huron location also offers primary care services including physicals, immunizations, STD testing, and counseling services for adolescents 10-21 years of age.

Both clinics accept insurance and are committed to reducing financial barriers for cash paying clients.
