Storing Medical Marijuana Safely

- If you use medical marijuana, it's
 important to store it safely away from
 children and pets. Just like any other drug,
 medication, or household chemical,
 medical marijuana and edibles must be
 kept secure and out of reach.
- Safe storage helps ensure that only the certified patient or designated caregiver has access.

Keep Your Medical Marijuana Safe in a Lockbox

- Kids, pets, or even curious visitors can get into medical marijuana if it's not locked up and out of sight. It's always best to keep marijuana in childresistant packaging and invest in a safe or lockbox to ensure the only person who can get to your medical marijuana is you.
- Call the Poison Control Hotline at 1-800-222-1222 if your child has accidentally eaten marijuana. Call 911 or go to the emergency room right away if your child is not breathing or is unconscious.
- Call the Pet Poison Helpline at <u>800-</u> <u>213-6680</u> or call your veterinarian if your pet has accidentally eaten marijuana.
