Introduction to the Onsite Wastewater Management (OWM) Customer Portal of the Michigan Environmental Health and Drinking Water Information System (MiEHDWIS) – our new software application.

What to expect: The focus of both meetings is to introduce the current OWM functionality, demonstrate the use of the MyWork-Customer Portal to submit requests for program assistance, upload files, and initiate EGLE consultations. We'll look at the way MiEHDWIS sends notifications to external customers – meaning you- and how external customers notify EGLE staff using workflows and by navigating in the system. Finally, you will see that the OWM Collaboration Portal is more than a file or record sharing tool.

As you see there are two dates offered with similar content being presented at each event and planned time for questions and input. Join us for one or both sessions.

Want to learn more? Called MiEHDWIS, or Eddy for short, the Drinking Water and Environmental Health Division's new software application is being developed and released in stages. The OWM portion of the application was released July 2021 and the Onsite Wastewater Program staff have since been learning how best to use the system to assist local health departments with requests and training needs. Several local health department subject matter experts are assisting and using OWM for actual projects or training requests. The application was developed to allow for collaboration between EGLE staff and the local health department user. Implementation of MiEHDWIS-OWM is being carefully thought through with both the program and our customers' needs – your needs – in mind.
