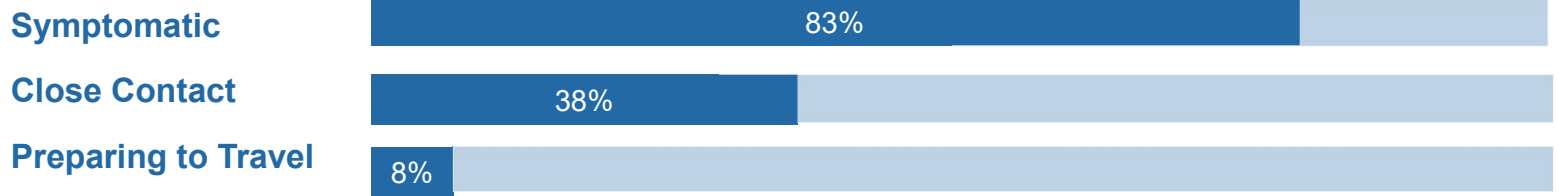

SUMMARY OF LOCAL CASE DATA WITH COMPARISON TO NATIONAL CONTROLS

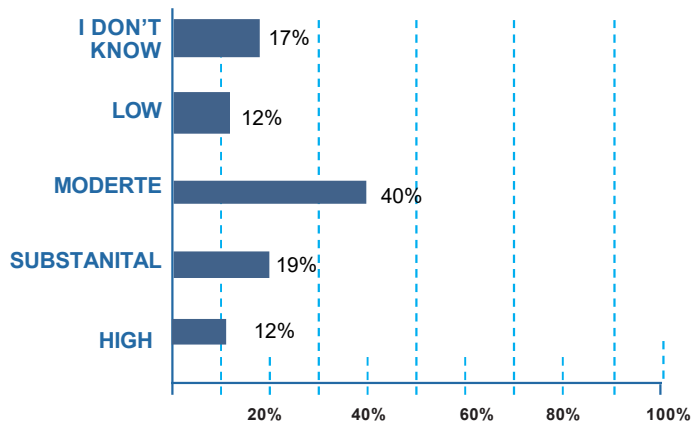
1594 people accessed the survey and consented. Fifty met the eligibility criteria between 15st – 28th July.

Which of the following would you use to describe the level of COVID-19 transmission in your local area?

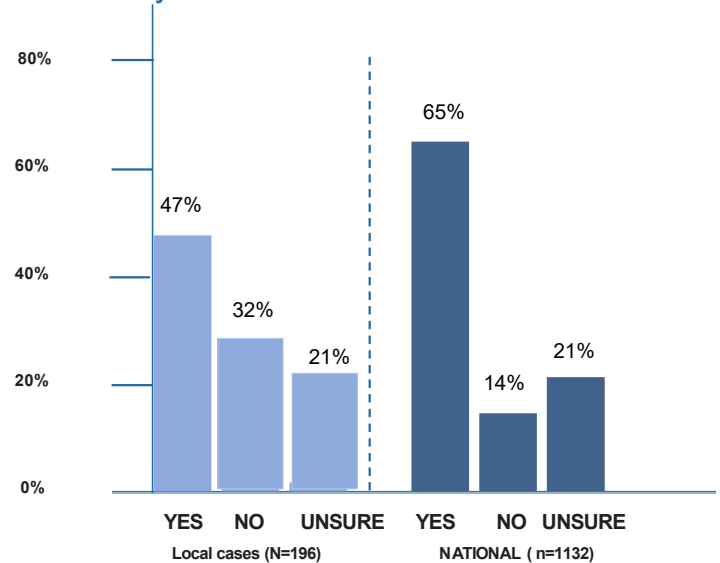

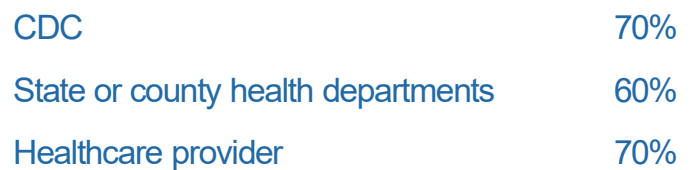


AT-HOME TREATMENTS

SUMMARY

- Average age of individuals who were positive was 48yrs (National average = 51.2yrs)
- 50% of cases had at least 3 vaccination doses.
- 40% used both PCR and rapid testing to confirm COVID. 20% used rapid testing.
- 10% delayed or avoided medical care in the past 3 months due to concerns related to COVID-19.
- 73% of individuals were concerned to very concerned about the severity of the new COVID strains
