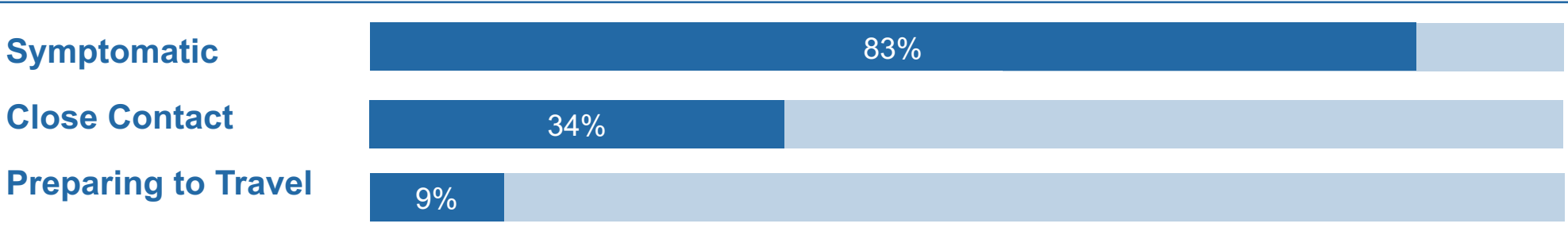

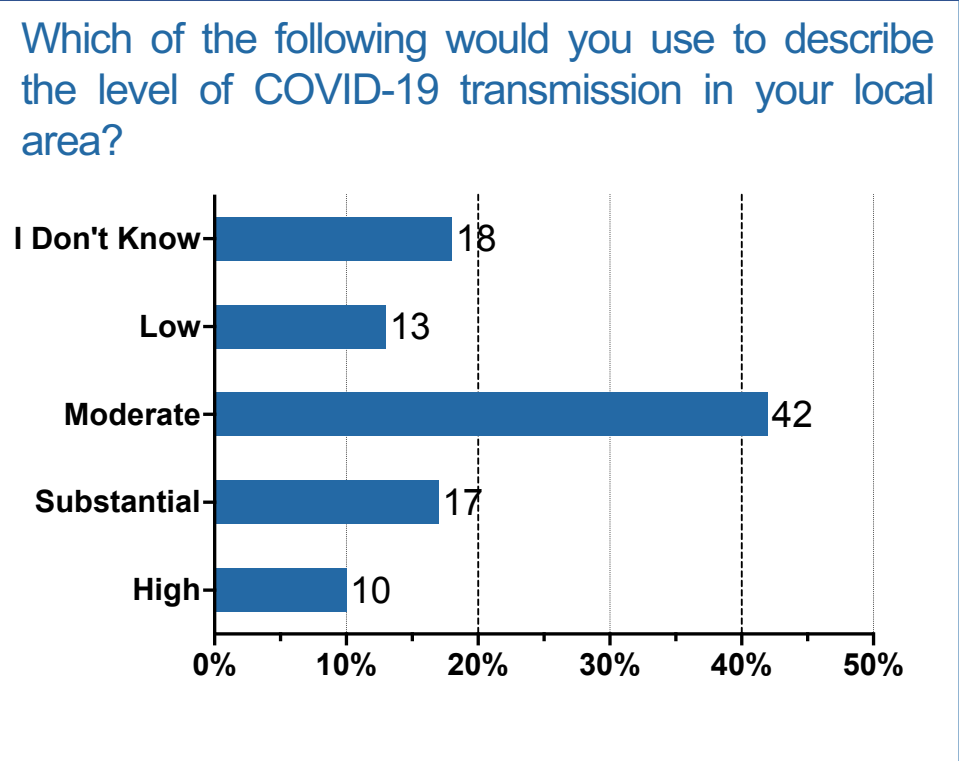
SUMMARY OF LOCAL CASE DATA WITH COMPARISON TO NATIONAL CONTROLS

2621 people accessed the survey, 2413 consented, and 2049 were eligible from 9th-21st September

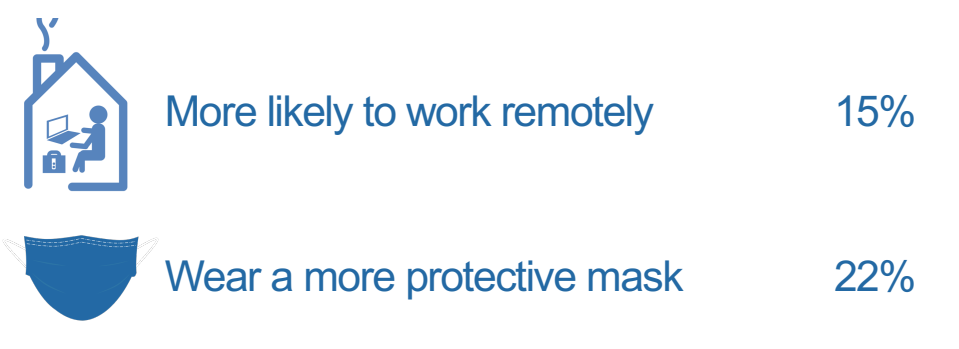
MOST COMMON REASONS FOR TESTING



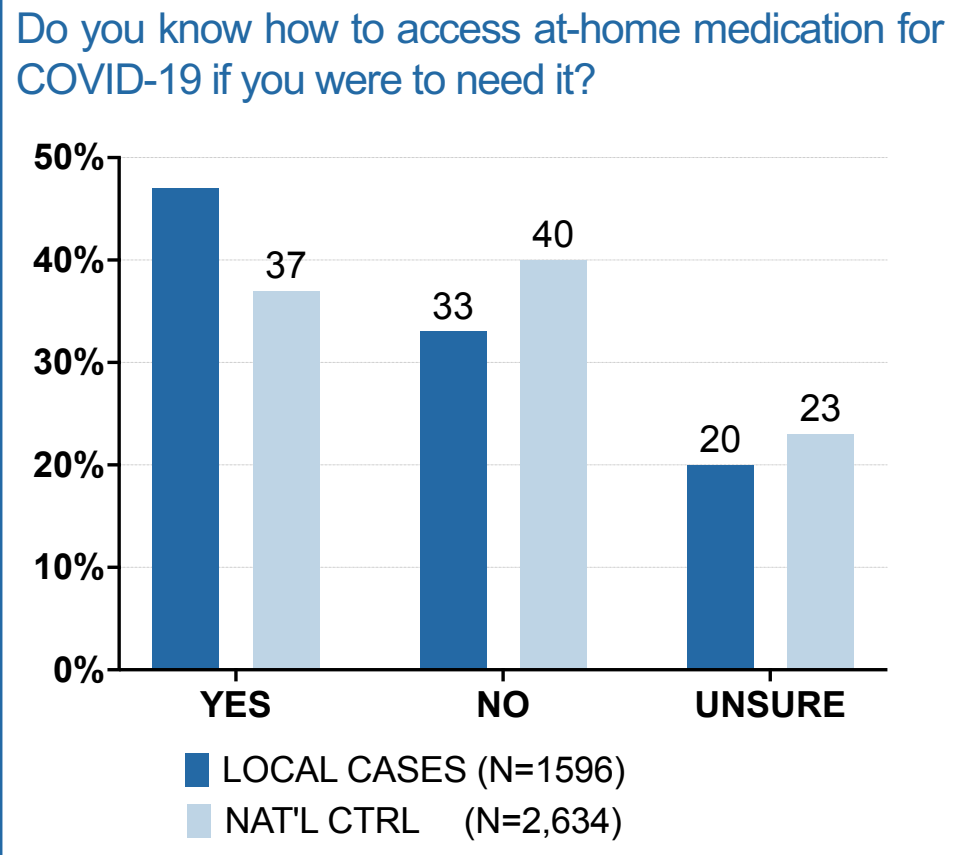
PERCEPTION OF LOCAL TRANSMISSION



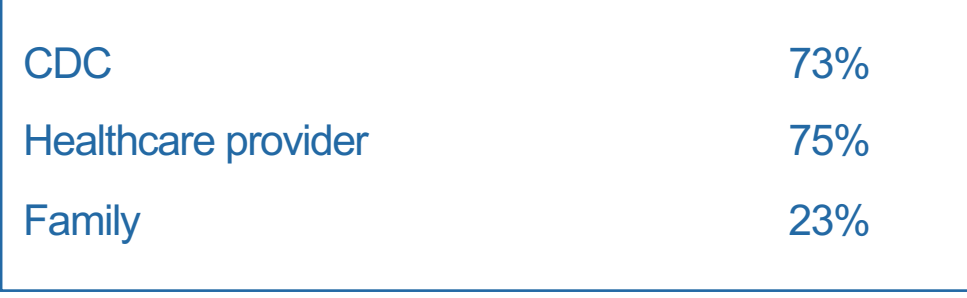
CHANGED BEHAVIORS DUE TO COMMUNITY TRANSMISSION

SUMMARY

- Most individuals (83%) are testing as a result of symptoms.
- 80% of cases had at least 3 vaccination doses
- 40% used both PCR and rapid testing to confirm positive COVID cases.
- Approximately 11% have delayed or avoided medical care in the past 3 months due to concerns related to COVID-19.
- Approximately 18% screened positive for anxiety and 15% screened positive for depression.
