

TRANSPORTATION OF MARIHUANA

In a Motor Vehicle



RECREATIONAL MARIHUANA

Transporting legally up to 2.5 ounces or less of marihuana, except that not more than 15 grams of marihuana may be in the form of a concentrate
MCL 333.27955.I(a)

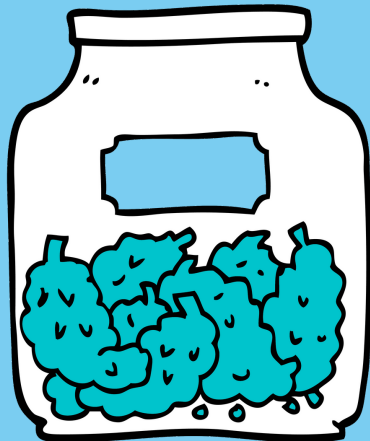


MEDICAL MARIHUANA

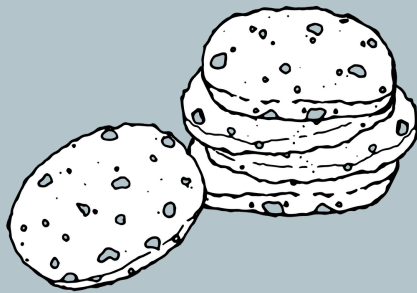
Privilege from arrest for qualifying patient &/or primary caregiver that presents registry ID Card & valid driver or government-issued identification card that bears a photographic image
MCL 333.26424

USABLE MARIHUANA

Legally transport anywhere in the vehicle an amount that does not exceed 2.5 ounces of marihuana (i.e. dried leaves, flowers, plant resin, or extract)
MCL 333.26423(h)
MCL 333.26423(n)



MARIHUANA - INFUSED PRODUCTS



MCL 333.26424(b)(3)
VIOLATION - CIVIL FINE \$250

PRIMARY CAREGIVER

Primary caregiver must have infused product in an enclosed case carried in the trunk & not readily accessible. A transportation manifest must indicate weight, destination, name & address of manufacturer, & departure date with ETA of arrival. A comprehensive receipt of delivery if applicable

QUALIFYING PATIENT

Qualifying patient must have product in sealed & labeled package carried in the trunk and not readily accessible. Labeling must state weight in ounces, manufacturer, date produced, recipient & date of receipt



MCL 333.26424(b)(2)
VIOLATION - CIVIL FINE \$250

Note: (c) For purpose of determining usable marihuana equivalency, the following is considered equal to 1 ounce

- (1) 16 ounces of infused product in solid form
- (2) 7 grams of infused product in gaseous form
- (3) 36 fluid ounces of infused product in a liquid form
